Learn to Skate Program, 2016-17 Season

Wildcat Youth Hockey Association provides boys and girls in Waunakee, Deforest, Lodi, Dane, Poynette and surrounding communities an opportunity to participate in the sport of youth hockey. The club has been in existence for more than 20 years. We are the youth hockey feeder program for the Deforest and Waunakee High School hockey programs.

Are you interested in introducing your child to skating and the sport of ice hockey? If so, then the Learn to Skate (LTS) program is ideal. The LTS program has two separate sessions. Each session runs about 10 weeks with a 1-hour practice session per week. Practices are typically on Saturdays starting at 8:00 AM. Skates and a hockey or bike helmet is all that is needed. Practice sessions will be held at the Ice Pond in Waunakee at 1110 Prairie View Drive.

Session 1: can vary some on Saturday mornings About 10 sessions in October, November, and December	Session 2: can vary, some on Saturday morning About 10 sessions in January, February, and March

A USA hockey registration number is required, which is free for kids 6 or under, as of Dec. 31. If your child is over 6 years of age and you are registering for LTS please contact our registrar (wyhareg@gmail.com) prior to registration to see about possibly waiving the USA hockey fee. The USA hockey fee is required for all other levels. Once registration is open you can visit this page to begin the registration process for the LTS program [REGISTER NOW](#).

Once the season starts there will be an opportunity to move your skater from LTS to LTP or U6 or U8 (they must be the correct birth year for U6 and U8). You should talk to one of the coaches at the LTS or LTP level about doing this.

The cost for the 2016-17 season is only \$ 75 per session. Skaters must have their own helmet (hockey or bike) and their own skates.
